Hollington Primary School Home-school agreement

As a school

We will do our best to:

- Support your child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment
- Help and encourage your child to reach their full potential
- Monitor and communicate with parents and carers regularly on your child's progress
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that caters for all children
- Promote high standards of behaviour so we can maintain a safe environment for all children
- Offer your child opportunities to develop a sense of responsibility, form healthy social relationships and build their self-esteem
- Set regular homework that supports the delivery of the curriculum and mark it where appropriate
- Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life
- Communicate between home and school through accessible newsletters, class dojo, text, email and the school website.
- Respond to communications from parents and carers in a timely manner, returning calls by the end of the next working day
- Notify parents in advance of PE timetable via Class Dojos to ensure children attend school in their PE kit on the required days
- Encourage good attendance, including arriving to and leaving school on time each day, and address any concerns with parents or carers where necessary
- Contact parents if spare clothes are not in children's bags to bring clothes in to school in the event of an accident.

Parents/carers

I will do my best to:

- Make sure my child attends school regularly and on time. I will notify the school if my child will be absent
- Make sure my child is dressed in the correct uniform and wears their PE kit to school on PE days
- Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour
- Encourage my child to try their best so they can reach their full potential
- Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn

The Pioneer Academy is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of all our pupils and expect all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.



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- > Make sure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff, speaking with the class teacher in the first instance
- > Understand that I should communicate with staff during core school hours, and although they may at times respond outside of those hours, I can't always expect that
- > Make sure that my child completes their homework on time, and raise any issues that my child has with their homework to their class teacher
- > Read and follow the school's policies (Policies can be found on the school website)
- > Treat all members of the school community with care and respect
- > Engage in parent meetings and work together with the school in order to achieve the best outcomes for my child
- > Ensure my child brings a spare change of clothes (trousers/underwear/socks) to school each day in case of accidents or falls to enable them to get changed into dry clothes. The school does not have spare clothing for children in these instances.
- > Read all communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary in a timely manner
- > Sign up to Class Dojo and ParentPay when my child joins the school
- > Provide consent for ALL school trips on ParentPay within the timescales set
- > Listen to my child read regularly or read with my child at least 4 times per week
- > Attend Parents Evenings

Pupils

I will do my best to:

- > Arrive at school on time every day that I can, and be ready to learn
- > Try my best to do my work and ask for help if I need it
- > Wear the correct school uniform everyday including the right footwear
- > Wear my PE kit to school on the my PE lesson day
- > Bring all the equipment I need each day
- > Be friendly and caring towards other children and adults
- > Always listen to instructions from the adults at school and follow the school rules
- > Do my homework and bring it back to school on time
- > Always look after the school equipment and be respectful of the school environment
- > Behave appropriately at all times throughout the school day
- > Behave appropriately on the way to and from school

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
